Represents growth and the natural wealth of Africa



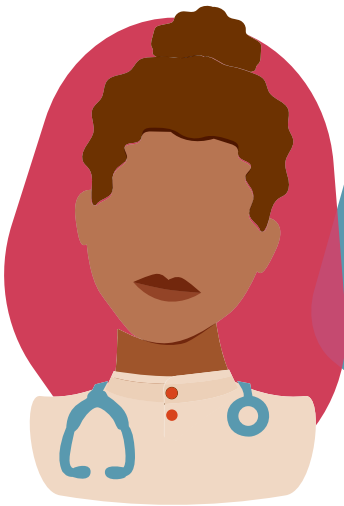
